

CANADIAN SOCIETY OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS (CSLA/AAPC) COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARDS

Purpose

The Canadian Society of Landscape Architects Community Service Awards recognize public agencies and community groups who have contributed significantly to environmental responsibility. These awards provide an opportunity to develop awareness of others who share CSLA's goals and to promote the profession's commitment to environmental sustainability.

Eligibility

Public agencies, community groups, members' clients and other entities directly providing community service are eligible to be nominated.

Frequency

The CSLA Community Awards can be awarded annually.

Nomination

1. Nominations may be for community service centered on activities at the local, regional or national level.
2. Nominations may originate from any CSLA member or Component Association.
3. Nominations are to be reviewed and supported by the Component Association and brought to the Board of Directors for consideration via the Component representative.
4. There is no limit to number of nominations.
5. The CSLA Board of Directors will review the nominations and make a recommendation as to which nominees should receive an award.
6. Nominations must be submitted to the Component Association in electronic format. Components must submit their recommendations by 1700 (EST) on April 30, 2010 the deadline for submission to executivedirector@csla.ca

Selection

The CSLA Recognition Awards Committee will review all nominations and refer no more than ten nominees to the CSLA/AAPC Board of Directors (BOD) for final selection. The BOD decision is by secret ballot.
