



CANADIAN SOCIETY OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS (CSLA-AAPC) SCHWABENBAUER RECOGNITION AWARD

Purpose

The CSLA Schwabenbauer Recognition Award is bestowed upon a member of the CSLA/AAPC in recognition of their unselfish and devoted service to the CSLA at the national level over a period of not less than five years.

Eligibility

The individual must be a member of the CSLA/AAPC.

Frequency

One Award may be awarded annually.

Nomination

Nominations may be made by any Member of the CSLA/AAPC (other than the Nominee), any component organization of the CSLA/AAPC, or by any associated organization of the CSLA/AAPC.

The Nomination package must be sent electronically to ExecutiveDirector@csla.ca and include the following:

1. A cover letter of nomination (no more than five pages in length) describing the qualifications of the nominee to receive the Award, describing the nominees contributions to the CSLA/AAPC and demonstrating how their service meets the purpose of the award;
2. A JPG 300 dpi photo of the nominee (as applicable);
3. Additional supporting materials (to a maximum of 15 pages) that clearly demonstrate the nominees contributions to the CSLA/AAPC; and,
4. A minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5) letters of endorsement.

Nominations must be received at executivedirector@csla.ca by 1700 (EST) on April 30, 2010, the date of deadline submissions.

Selection Criteria

The CSLA Schwabenbauer Recognition Award will be bestowed on an individual who exemplifies the qualities by service to the Association by demonstrating:

- Contributions that have had a substantial meaningful impact on the CSLA/AAPC as an organization, and/or to the membership of the Association;
- Advancement of the Association through the nominees professional and personal contributions; and
- A passion and enthusiasm for the profession of landscape architecture.

Selection

Each nomination is judged for the success with which the nomination package demonstrates the candidate's service and contribution to the CSLA/AAPC. Entries are weighed individually--not in competition with each other. The Recognition Awards Committee retains the right to request additional information on candidates as deemed necessary during deliberations. The Recognition Awards Committee will review all nominations and refer no more than two nominees to the CSLA/AAPC Board of Directors (BoD) for final selection. The BoD decision is by secret ballot.

Announcement and Presentation

The CSLA Schwabenbauer Recognition Award recipient is notified by the CSLA/AAPC President and invited to attend the CSLA Annual Congress Gala where the Award will be presented. Announcement of the Award will be made in the CSLAAAPC *Bulletin*, by Press Release and on the website csla.ca in addition to the presentation at the event.
