

## **CANADIAN SOCIETY OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS (CSLA-AAPC) LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

### **Purpose**

The CSLA- AAPC Lifetime Achievement Award is the honour the Canadian Society of Landscape Architects may bestow upon a landscape architect whose lifetime achievements and contributions to the profession have had a unique and lasting impact on the welfare of the public and on the environment.

### **Eligibility**

The individual must be a landscape architect. Nominations are limited to members of the CSLA-AAPC.

### **Frequency**

One award may be awarded annually.

### **Nomination**

Nominations may be made by any Member of the CSLA-AAPC, any component organization of the CSLA-AAPC, or by any associated organization of the CSLA-AAPC.

The Nomination package must include the following:

- a cover letter of nomination (no more than 1000 words) describing the qualifications of the nominee to receive the award, demonstrating that the nominee's professional achievement has supported the purpose of the award;
- a photo of the nominee (as applicable);
- a resume, including a list of relevant projects or employment related to landscape architecture;
- additional supporting materials (to a maximum of 15 pages) such as photographs of projects, drawings, project descriptions, articles, etc. clearly demonstrating the nominee's continued professional achievements and contributions; and,
- a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of five (5) letters of endorsement.

Nominations must be received at the CSLA office by 1700 (EST) on the date of deadline submission set annually for the year of the award.

### **Selection Criteria**

The Lifetime Achievement Award will be awarded to an individual who exemplifies the following qualities by demonstrating:

- excellence in the field of practice as a landscape architect (such as policy, research, project planning, design, or a combination of professional activities);
- societal, technical or environmental advancement through landscape architecture;
- that their contributions have had a substantial meaningful impact on both people and nature and that their works are known and respected by other landscape architects;
- advancement of the profession of landscape architecture through professional and personal contributions; and,
- a passion and enthusiasm for the profession of landscape architecture.

### **Selection**

Each nomination is judged for the success with which the nomination package demonstrates the candidate's lifetime achievement and contribution to landscape architecture. Entries are weighed individually--not in competition with each other. The Recognition Awards Committee retains the right to request additional information on candidates as deemed necessary during deliberations. The Recognition Awards Committee will review all nominations and refer no more than two nominees to the CSLA - AAPC Board of Directors (BoD) for final selection. The BoD decision is by secret ballot.

### **Announcement and Presentation**

The Award recipient is notified by the CSLA – AAPC President and invited to attend the CSLA Annual Congress Dinner where the award will be presented. Announcement of the Award will be made in the CSLA - AAPC Bulletin, and by Press Release.
